Helfer, M. E., Keme R. S. & Drugman, R. D. (2008). *The battered child*. (5th ed.). Chicago: University of Chicago Press.

Book with no date

When there is no date use (n.d.). in place of the date

Cody, J. P. (n.d.). *Delmar's medical assisting exam review: Preparation for CMA and RMA exams*. Clifton Park, NY: Delmar Publishers.

Book without author

When there is no author begin the citation with the title followed by the date.

Multivolume work (or anthology) with one editor

Multivolume work (or anthology) with two editors

Duncan, G. J. & Brooks-Gunn, J. (Eds.). (2011). *Consequences of growing up poor*. New York: Russell Sage Foundation.
